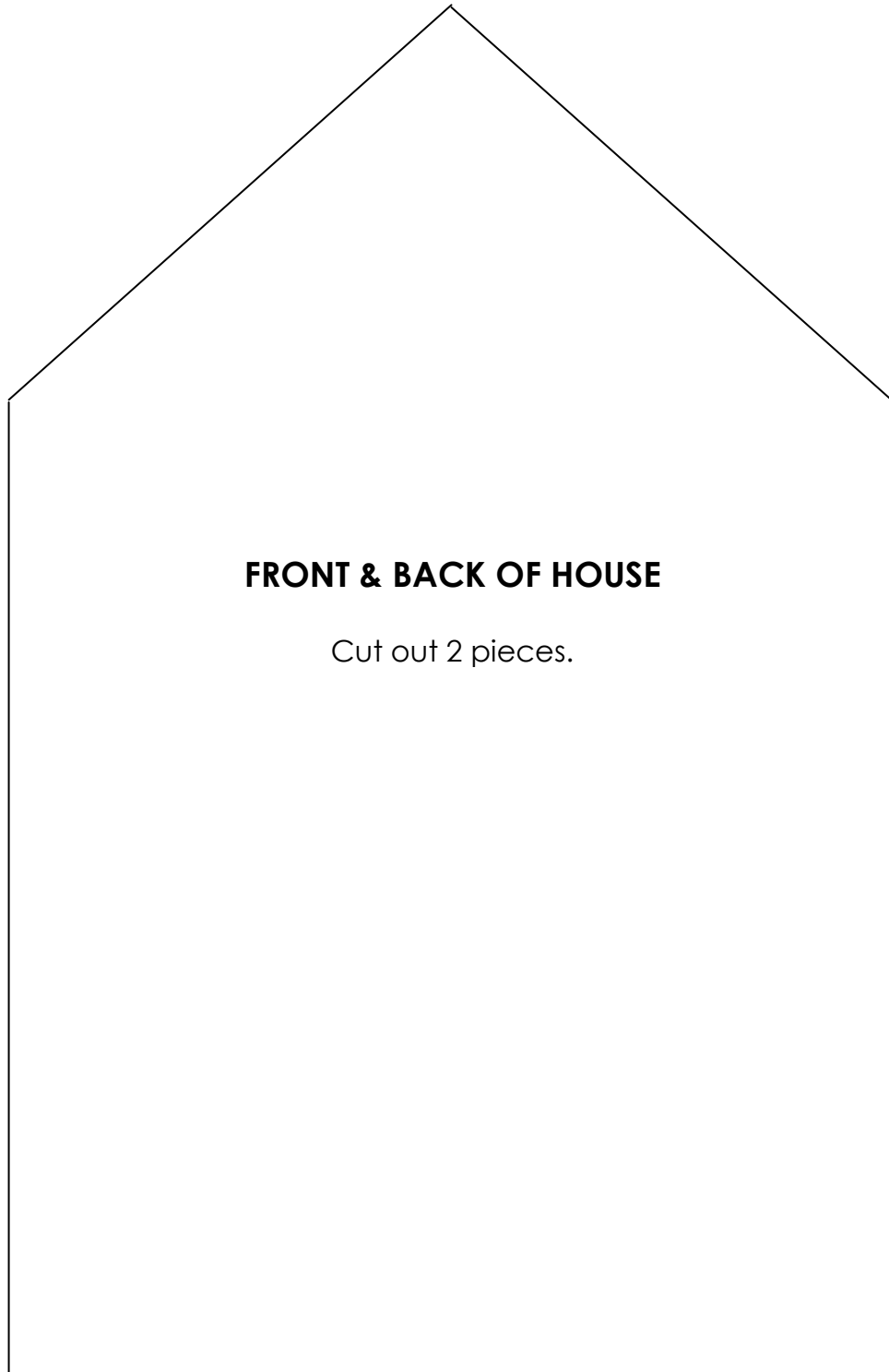


DIY Gingerbread House Tissue Box Template

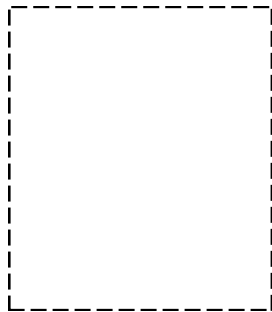
SIDES OF HOUSE

Cut out 2 pieces.

ROOF

Cut out 2 pieces.

On one piece, cut out a rectangle
(along the dotted lines) for the
chimney opening.



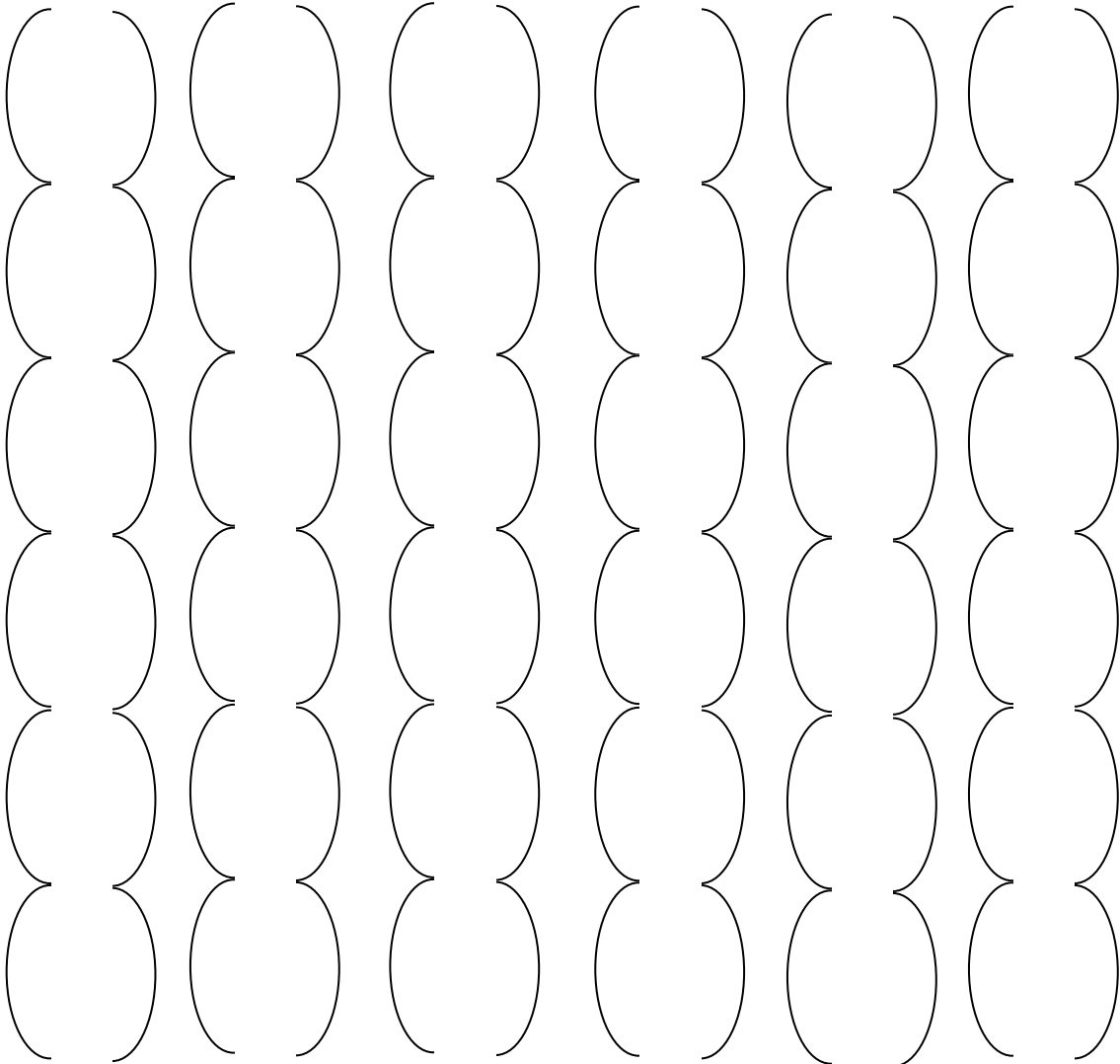
**FRONT & BACK
OF CHIMNEY**
Cut out 2 pieces
that are reverse
images of
each
other.

**TALL SIDE
OF CHIMNEY**
Cut out 1 piece.

**SHORT SIDE
OF CHIMNEY**
Cut out 1 piece.

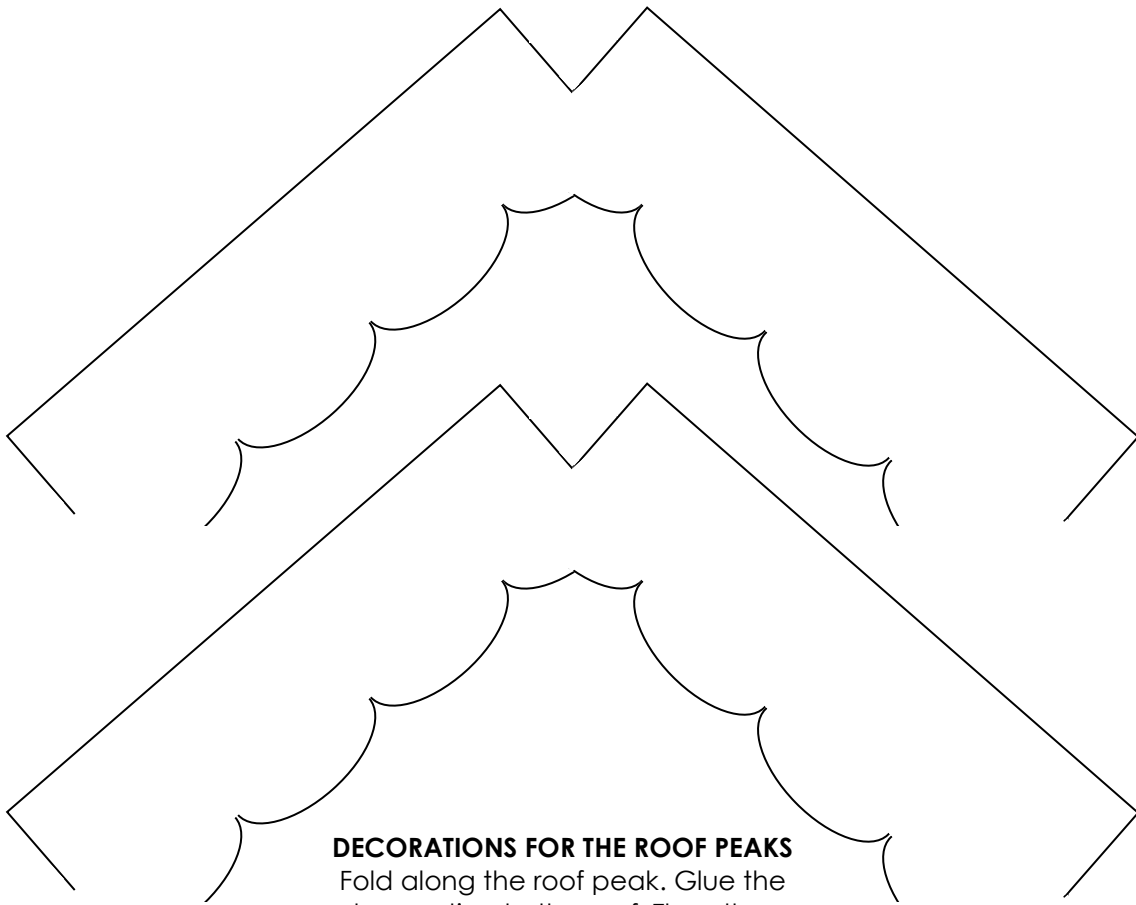
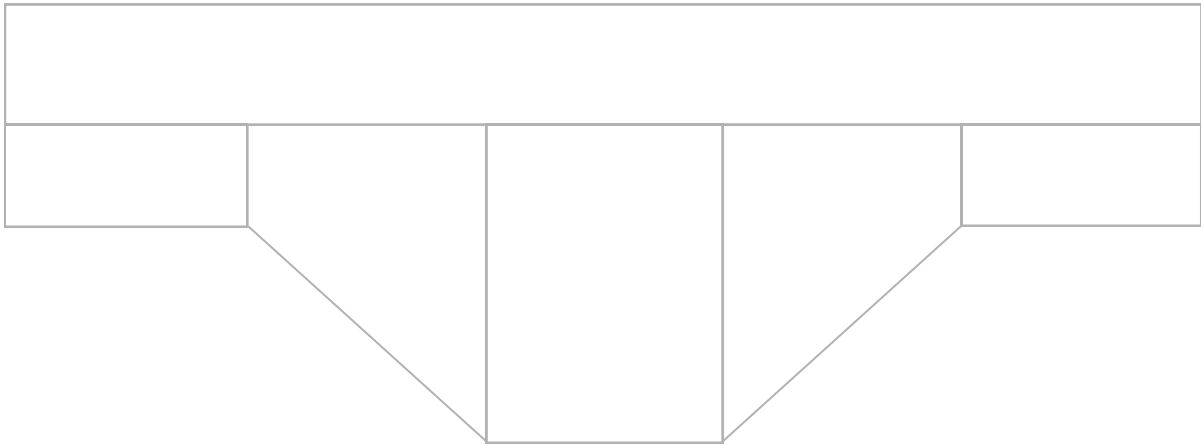
“FROSTING” FOR THE SEAMS OF THE GINGERBREAD HOUSE.

Cut out and fold lengthwise before gluing to the house.



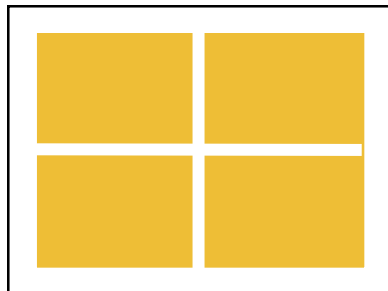
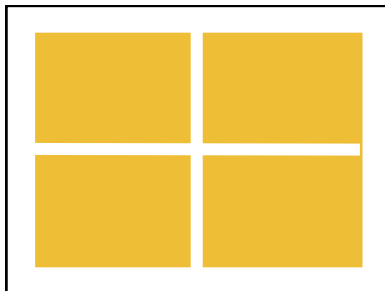
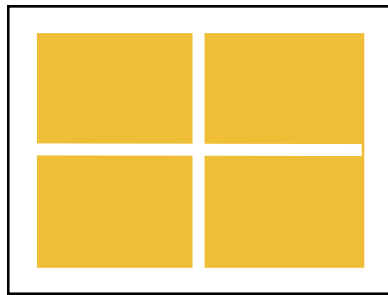
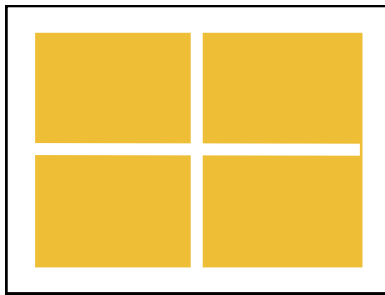
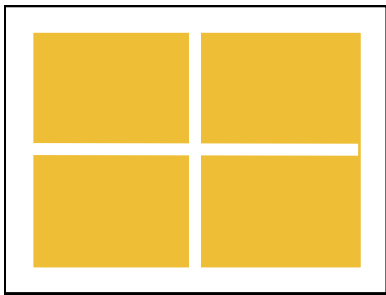
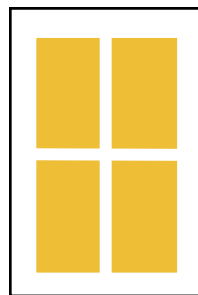
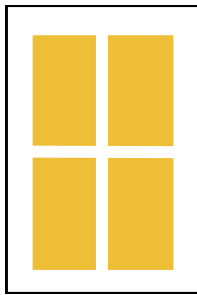
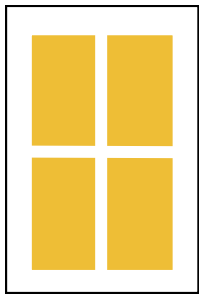
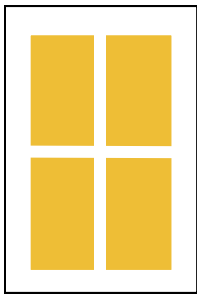
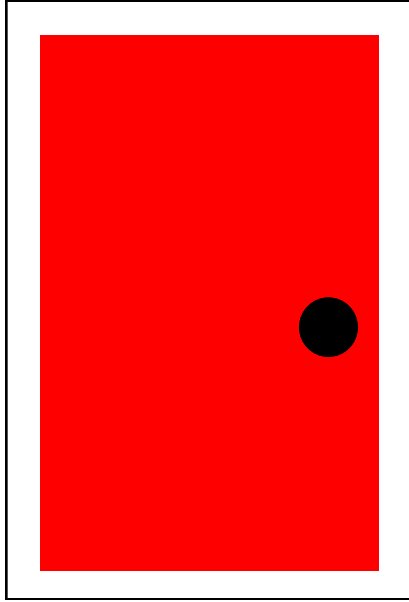
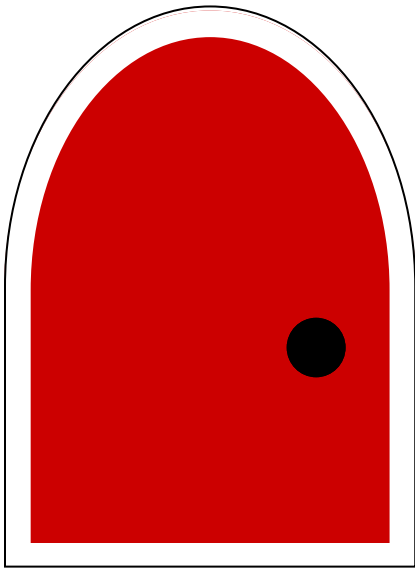
CHIMNEY COVER

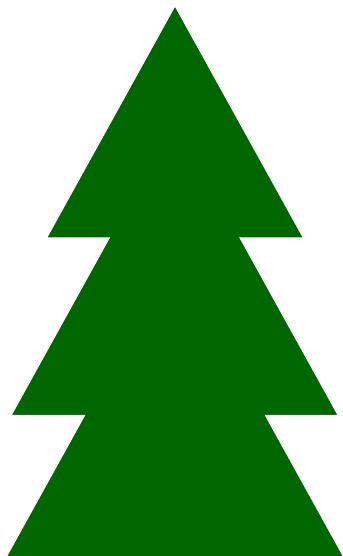
Cut around the entire shape, and then fold on the horizontal and vertical lines. Place the printed side face-down against the chimney and glue down. The top rectangle will fold down over the top of the chimney and be glued to the inside. To make it easier to fold, cut small triangles out at each corner of the chimney and then fold the pieces down inside.



DECORATIONS FOR THE ROOF PEAKS

Fold along the roof peak. Glue the top portion to the roof. The other portion will hang down.





DECORATIONS FOR THE ROOF

Cut out the rectangle and then scallop the edges of the roof.
Fold along the "frosting" seam. Cut a rectangle to accommodate
your chimney.
